



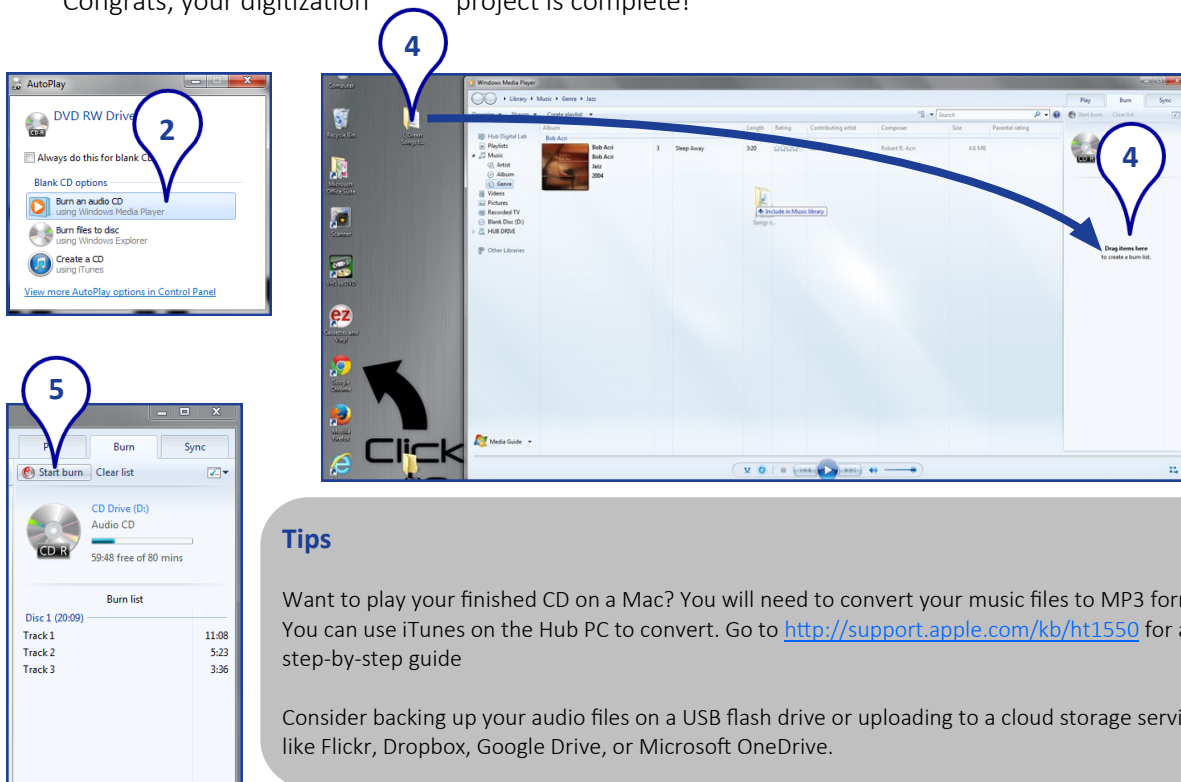
# Burn a Music CD

Using Windows Media Player

Use this guide to turn your digital music files into a finished CD using Windows Media Player. You will need a blank CD-R or CD-RW. It will take approximately 10 minutes to complete.

## STEP ONE: SET UP

1. Once you have finished converting your cassette/LPs, you are ready to save your project to a blank CD. Insert a blank CD into the computer's CD drive.
2. A small dialogue box will appear. Click on the **Burn an audio CD using Windows Media Player** option.
3. The Windows Media Player application will open. The program will recognize your blank CD and display a blank **Burn list**.
4. On the computer's Desktop, you will find a folder containing your saved cassette/lp conversion project. Click, drag, and drop that folder into the white area in Windows Media Player where it says **Drag items here to create a burn list**.
5. Your digital music tracks should now appear in the Burn list. Click on **Start burn**.
6. When the CD burn process has completed, the computer's CD drive will eject your finished CD. Congrats, your digitization project is complete!



### Tips

Want to play your finished CD on a Mac? You will need to convert your music files to MP3 format. You can use iTunes on the Hub PC to convert. Go to <http://support.apple.com/kb/ht1550> for a step-by-step guide
