Licensure required are a valid Michigan Motor Vehicle Operator's license and a Licensed Bachelors Social Work (LBSW). Strongly preferred licenses or required depending upon placement: LMSW, LLMSW, TLLP, LLP, LP, LPC. A minimum of 1-3 years experience is required, depending on licensure, in the mental health field working with the targeted youth population. **Bilingual ability in Spanish/English is strongly desired.**
